## From Lament to Hope: A Lenten Study with Bishop Kennetha of the Psalms of Lament

The psalms were Israel's hymnbook. And psalms of lament were Israel's expression of grief in the midst of trial. For this season of Lent, Bishop Kennetha invites you to join her for a conference-wide online study that will explore both personal and communal psalms as we focus on events impacting our world and our lives.

In particular, we will pray for peace in the Holy Land, Ukraine, and our own nation. As we move from Lent to Easter, we will see how the psalms can lead us to hope.

This Lenten study will give us the opportunity to strengthen our relationships with each other and with our worldwide United Methodist connection as we invite special guests to share on the topics we address. We will conclude with an annual conference-wide opportunity to worship together and take action for peace.

Sessions will be held over four Tuesday nights (February 27, March 5, March 12, and March 19) on Zoom beginning at 7:00 pm. Participants will have an opportunity for conversation and prayer in breakout rooms. You can register on the Iowa Conference website.

#### IS IT SPRING YET? Highlights from Laura

While we wait, patiently? for Spring why not select a STAR word for the new year. I wrote a devotion about this prayer practice in January. The idea is that a list of 120 intentional words, or guiding words, can be written or printed on paper stars. You select a random number and that word is yours. Place your star word somewhere you will see it regularly to allow reflection on how God has moved through, around or in connection to that word.

Throughout history stars have been used as navigational tools. Scripture gives us powerful examples of how stars move us closer to Jesus. The Magi followed the star and it guided them to Bethlehem. Stars show God's power, wisdom, and His faithfulness. God uses multiple ways to guide us and speak to us. Star words invite us to connect with God.

There are other ways to use your star word, including look up the definition of your word, even if it is a word, you know well. You could look into the etymology of the word and how its meaning has changed throughout history. What does this word remind you of? Does it recall any memories or experiences? How might God be speaking to you through this word? See if you can find your word—or a synonym – in the Bible. What scripture passages can you find? How is the word used in these passages? Write or speak aloud a prayer using your word. Invite your family and friends to join you on this journey. You can even select your own word by reading scripture, praying, and listening for God to reveal a word that is just right for you. For example, I have two words, "creativity" and "sunrise", I wonder how these words will draw me closer to God. I am not an early riser but maybe God is leading me toward a new routine.
