

Trinity UMC Winter Weather Service Cancellation Policy

In the event that any one of the following winter weather stipulations are met, church service at Trinity United Methodist of Fort Dodge will be cancelled.

- An active “Winter Storm Warning” is, or will be, taking place at the time that the church service is set to begin.
- The “Wind Chill” or “Real Feel” temperature is predicted to be at, or below, negative 20 degrees at the time that the church service is set to begin.
- The parking lot/walkways have not been cleared of snow within 2 hours of the time that the church service is set to begin.

Any cancellation of a church service due to this winter weather policy will be communicated in the following manner. (This list may be updated in the future as more avenues for notification are adopted.)

- Posts on the church Facebook page
- Local television news stations, such as KCCI, will be notified
- Local radio stations under Alpha Media will be notified

In the event of a cancellation of a Saturday evening service, it will NOT automatically mean the cancellation of the following Sunday morning service. The following Sunday service will only be cancelled if one of the above mentioned stipulations are met.

In the event of a cancellation of either a Saturday evening service or a Sunday morning service, there will NOT be a livestreamed service from the church sanctuary as it has already been deemed unsafe for any individuals to travel to church, including those involved with putting on a livestreamed service from the sanctuary. Every effort WILL be made however for a short service of prayer and devotion to be livestreamed by the Pastor individually from the Parsonage.
